One of the first questions to be asked was why a Zinc Metal Roof? The answer is because it allows a lower profile roof and therefore will not impact on the skyline as greatly as a tiled roof (which requires more support and has to be at a far steeper angle), this will be kinder to the neighbours who have to look at it and make it less imposing. It will also tip a wink to the old hall and it's construction. The zinc roof also allows a good level of insulation with regard to both heat and noise, plus it also easily allows for skylights to be placed in certain areas of the building.
